Béla Bartók was born in Nagyszentmiklós, Hungary (now Sănnicolaul-Mare, Romania), on March 25, 1881. His father was director of a government agricultural school, his mother, a teacher and pianist. She gave Béla his first piano lesson on his fifth birthday; his great gifts as pianist soon became evident, and at the age of 9 he began to compose.
