1. Create an account (FSA ID). Student: An FSA ID is a username and password you need to sign the FAFSA form online.If you don't have an FSA ID, get an FSA ID here ASAP. It takes about 10 minutes to create an FSA ID. If this will be your first time filling out the FAFSA form, you'll be able to use your FSA ID right away to sign and submit your FAFSA form online.

FAFSA ® Deadlines. Many states and colleges set priority deadlines by which you must submit the FAFSA form to be considered for the aid programs they administer. There is also a federal deadline each academic year. Select your state of legal residence and the school year for which you're applying for federal student aid.

You can file your 2017-18 FAFSA as early as Oct. 1, 2016, rather than beginning on Jan. 1, 2017. The earlier submission date will be a permanent change, enabling you to complete and submit a FAFSA as early as

October 1 every year. 2. You'll use earlier income and tax information.
