Mud logging is a useful evaluation technique that has developed since the advent of rotary drilling in the 1920's. Since mud circulates constantly during drilling, mud logging can provide information on a continuous formation sample. A mud logger checks mud for oil and gas and collects bit cuttings for analysis.

Mud logging includes observation and microscopic examination of drill cuttings (formation rock chips), and evaluation of gas hydrocarbon and its constituents, basic chemical and mechanical parameters of drilling fluid or drilling mud (such as chlorides and temperature), as well as compiling other information about the drilling parameters.
