STARVATION RATIONS FOR BOTH POLES AND JEWS. In the spring of 1940, the Germans imposed a food-rationing policy in which Germans were allowed 2,600 calories per day, the Poles 670, and the Jews 184. (p. 53). So the Polish and Jewish rations were closer to each other than either was to the German ration.
