### Northern California Valley Sheet Metal Workers Training ...

Prior to the completion of the pre-apprentice period, but after employing the pre-apprentice for at least 500 hours, the employer may request to the JATC for early indenture. At the time of application, applicants will be required to take a test designed to determine competence in mechanical aptitude, mathematics, and reading comprehension.
